PROGRESS OF ACTIVITIS DURING 2021-22:

3. Climate Proofing project / programme (CPP)-NABARD:

With a view to address climate impacts, NBARD has launched programmes in completed watersheds which complement and supplement the efforts village communities. The proposed Climate Proofing project / programme is one of them which will add value to the current initiative and improve resilience to climate variability and with focus on mitigation and adaptation practices to climate related negative situation impacting the livelihoods of vulnerable communities in watershed areas. It will focus on vulnerable communities like small and marginal farmers who are going to be impacted largely by the changes in climate. SHARP has been facilitating two CPP projects each in Dhanvada and Devarampally of Jayashankar Bhpalapally (earstwhile Karimnagar) and Ananatham of Yadadri Bhongir (earstwhile Nalgonda)

The programme is going to enhance the adaptive capacity of the community in general and farmers in particular. The project looks at resilience of the watersheds much beyond the usual soil and water conservation focused drought proofing measures and is beyond the business-as-usual practice and can be considered as concrete adaptation.

Major achievements:

- **NRM Works:** Under the project, Loose boulder Structures (LBS), Rock Filled Dams (RFDs), Farm Ponds (FPs) were constructed with a object to conserve the soil and moisture.
- **Leaf Colour Chart:** these charts are installed in paddy field for which they are supposed to be.
- **Agri.Tool bank for FPO:** With a view to make available all agri implements to watershed farmers, under control of FPO, this activity is proposed.
- **Recharge of Bore well:** To augment the yield of agriculture bore wells, Bore well recharge structures are constructed.
- **Drip Irrigation:** Under better and judicial water management practices, Drip system are distributed to the project beneficiaries.
- **Bio-fertilizers:** As Bio fertilizers contain adequate quantities of N, P, K and several micronutrients essential for plant growth which will maintain the soil health, crop production is reportedly increased.
- **Bio-Control Agents:** Bio control agents are applied for 25 acres. The total cost incurred towards these units is Rs. 25000.
- **Deep ploughing:** The purpose of **deep ploughing** is to modify the soil water retention characteristics over the long time and ploughing depth normally above 30 cms.
- **Tank Silt application:** The Silt is dug from bed level of nearest tank and is deposited in the lands of farmers. Most of these beneficiary farmers are small and marginal farmers.
- **Green manure cultivation:** Under green maturing crops, daincha is applied into the fields. Daincha seeds are procured from agriculture department on subsidy basis.
- **Pandal Based Veg Cultivation:** To intensify the vegetable cultivation, Pandal based vegetable cultivation is practiced in the project villages. Pandals are supported by stone poles erected in organized way. Creepers are spread over the GI wired mat over the pandal.
- **Pheromone traps & Egg cards:** To balance the population of allied pests and enemy pest at larva and subsequent stage, Egg cards and Pheromone traps are used. Pheromone traps are installed in Cotton crop. Typical pheromone traps are installed for respective type of pests. Egg cards are installed in paddy fields.

- **Promotion of Millet Plots:** As the CPP area is relatively under moderate rainfall with red murum soil; millets are suited to grow in this area. Millets such as, Korra, and Jowar are promoted.
- **Mulching demo units:** Mulching demo units are installed in the CPP area. Each unit of material approximately covered couple of farmers.
- **Posters and pamphlet on climate change adaptation:** Posters and pamphlets are prepared on typical climate risks and respective adaptations practices.

4.Integrated Water Management Scheme(IWMS):

As it is aware, water conservation campaign was implemented by NABARD during 2017, covering 101569 villages spread over 250 districts with focus on promoting efficient water conservation management technologies and other water smart practices in agriculture by way of facilitating credit flow, convergence of public/ corporate resources and leveraging voluntary actions of the village community.

In order to consolidate the outcomes of the above campaign and take concrete measures to enhance the water availability and water-use efficiency in select villages, NABARD has approved a scheme "Integrated Water Management Scheme through Watershed approach", in principle to be implemented in 250 villages, spread over 50 districts in the country during 2018-19 to 2019-20.

Out of these 50 districts, 40 are aspirational districts identified by the Government of India and the remaining 10 districts were identified by the concerned –NABARD-Ros.

In this regard, as guided by NABARD, SHARP has identified the following 5 villages in Atmakur(M) and Motakondur mandals of Yadadi Bhongir district; and being implementing the IWMS.

- Singaram
- Muripirala
- Kalvapally
- Chandepally
- Chamapur

Major achievements:

- **NRM Works:** Under the project, NFB, Loose boulder Structures (LBS), Rock Filled Dams (RFDs), Gabion Structures(GBS), Farm Ponds (FPs), Mini Percolation Tanks(MPTs) were constructed with a object to soil-moisture conservation and water harvesting.
- **Promotion of Millet Plots:** As the CPP area is relatively under moderate rainfall with red murum soil; millets are suited to grow in this area. Millets such as, Korra, and Jowar are promoted.
- **Horticulture Plantation:** Guava like plants were planted under the project.
- **Drip Irrigation:** Under better and judicial water management practices, Drip system are distributed to the project beneficiaries.
- **Mulching demo units:** units of Mulching demo units are installed in the project area same were distributed to 5 farmers.
- **Pandal Based Veg Cultivation:** To intensify the vegetable cultivation, Pandal based vegetable cultivation is practiced in the project villages. Pandals are supported by stone poles erected in organized way. Creepers are spread over the GI wired mat over the pandal.
- Following training and exposure programmes were organized under the project:
 - High density cropping system
 - Mandal level interface and convergence meeting with line departments.
 - Exposure on Zeero based Natural Farming (ZBNF)
 - Integrated water management practices.

5. Farmers Producers Organizations (FPOs):

Backdrop: National vision about the FPOs is to build a prosperous and sustainable agriculture sector by promoting and supporting member-owned Producer Organizations, that enable farmers to enhance productivity through efficient, cost-effective and sustainable resource use and realize higher returns for their produce, through collective action supported by the government, and fruitful collaboration with academia, research agencies, civil society and the private sector.

With an object of building and promotion of Farmers Producer Organization, NABARD has sanctioned two FPOs to SHARP NGO under PRODUCE Fund. Both of These FPOs were registered under company Act.

- **Prasanna Farmers Producer Company Ltd.** covering of 3 watershed villages viz., Ananatharam, Seetharampuram & Brahmanapalli of Gundala mandal and Theryala of Motakondur mandal fall in Yadadri Bhongir (erstwhile Nalgonda).
- **Susthira Farmers Producer Company Ltd.** Covering 3 watershed villages viz., Devarampalli, Dhanvada and Bayyaram of Kataram mandal fall in Jayashankar Bhupalapalli district (erstwhile Karimnagar).
- **Navyasri Farmer Producer Company Ltd.** covering of 5 villages viz., Moripirala, Kalvapally, Singaram, Modukgukunra and Chinnagudem of Athmakur (m) mandal in Yadadri Bhongir (erstwhile Nalgonda).
- **Chada Farmer Producer Company Ltd.** covering of 5 villages viz., Chada, Muttireddygudem, Katepally, Kondapuram and Chandepally of Motakondur mandal in Yadadri Bhongir (erstwhile Nalgonda).

Major achievements:

- Took the farmers of FPO for trainings cum exposure on different thematically areas.
- Organized the orientation programmes to increase the share capital.
- Prepared the Business Development Plan for FOPs.
- Promoted the guide farmers for dissemination of FPO concept and to improve the business profits.
- A cumulative business of about 28 lakhs is achieved till now.
- All Licenses are renewed regarding Seeds, Fertilizer and pesticides are taken from Department of agriculture.

6. Watershed Livelihood Program (WDF & IGWDP):

Though the Soil and water conservation activities are completed under WDF and IGWDP projects; livelihood related funds kept under respective 6 watershed project Livelihood accounts. Both, LH and MF together a total of around **3.00 crores** (including outstanding) in all together 6 watershed projects are there. NGO is regularly closely monitoring these funds through Livelihood para professionals. Recoveries of already distributed loans are under continuation rather fresh loans. All related books and accounts are being maintained by the NGO.

❖ *General Programmes:*

7. Programmes in the wake of COVID-19:

During COVID-19 pandemic situation, SHARP-NGO team provided the essential supplies to 32 migrant families on a weekly basis in few villages of Gundala Mandal. During the programme, essential food items were delivered on door-to-door basis are viz. Dry ration (grains, pulses, sugar, oil and powdered milk etc.), -Fresh produce (vegetable, fruits etc.) and-Meala parcel (Food, water, milk, biscuits etc.).

- Other highlights of the programme are under:
 - a. Kit (Item & Quantity): Rice-10kg, oil-1kg, Dal-1kg, Tamarind -1/2kg, Salt-1kg, Dental soap-2, Onion-1kg, Bottle ground-1, Beera-1kg, Cucumber-2kg, Ladyfinger-1kg, Face masks-2
 - b. No. of families/ Households covered: 32
 - c. No. of Individuals/ Population covered: 98
 - d. Duration of programme: April 2020
 - e. Contribution/ mobilization from other agency (Name, Address & Amount): Indian Red Cross Society, Mothkur
- **Participation/ involvement of Government Officer/ Other Agencies:** Concerned Mandal level Officers i.e., Mandal Revenue Officer (MRO), Sub Inspector (SI) and District Chairman Red cross society (NALGONDA).

8. Blood Donation Camp:

To save the life's of injured or needy people for blood these camps were planned and organized by the NGO under the part of social service. NGO team coordinates with Doctors and mobilizes the people particularly of village youth. Under the guidance of doctors the blood is collected from donors and used to be preserved for needy people with free of cost. During the period, camps are organized in Mothkur mandal of Yadadri Bhongir district.

9. Health Camps:

The SHARP NGO organized health camps in rural areas where the people not accessible to the health sources. The women especially undergone treatment in this health camp by the doctors the specialists from each department came and given the treatment to the people. The NGO also taken up the risk to mobilize the people from villages to attend the health camp. Local leaders from Panchayat Raj (PRI) Institutions are also participated in this health camp. During the period, camps are organized in Gundala& mothkur mandal of Yadadri Bhongir district.

10. Child labor awareness programme:

Every year SHARP organizes child labor awareness programmes at villages where the children are engaged as labor force in work places viz., Bricks Units, agriculture and ancillary industries etc., during the period, awareness programmes are organized in Gundala and Mothkur mandal of Yadadri Bhongir district.

11. Cultural Programmes:

The SHARP NGO organizes the cultural programmes on various village level issues viz., social, health, education, child labpor, women and other related themes. Village level volunteers are motivated to participate and to make others to participate in the programme. The camp organized with kalajathas including cultural songs and folk dances. NGO team coordinates with the line departmens and mobilize the people with support of village volunteers to make the programmes successfully. During the period, camps are organized in Gundala mandal of Yadadri Bhongir district.
